Paper Records

10,000 pages

20 reams of paper
(500 pages per ream)

About 100 lbs. of paper!

2 full cases of paper
(10 reams per case)

Other Disadvantages of Paper:

- Multiple boxes to keep up with and transport
- Longer processing time
- Higher risk of damage or loss

Paper

- 10,000 pages
- 100 lbs
- Multiple boxes



USB

- 10,000 pages
- 0.2 oz
- Fits in a pocket



CD

- 10,000 pages
- 0.6 oz
- Single disc
